

Handwriting Policy

We aim to get all of our children joining their letters correctly by the end of Year 2. If there is a capital letter at the start of the word, we don't join that.

To begin with we will teach the children the initial letter shapes un-joined before moving on to joined letters.

Un-joined cursive letter formation

a b c d e f g h i j k l m n o p q r s t u v w x y z

Joined cursive letter formation

a b c d e f g h i j k l m n o p q r s t u v w x y z

Capital letters and number formation

A B C D E F G H I J K L M N O P Q R
S T U V W X Y Z 0 1 2 3 4 5 6 7 8 9

Once children are confident hand writers they will progress onto a black handwriting pen. We will then encourage children to create their own unique, consistent style of handwriting.
