Dear Parent/Carers,

We have had a very busy week with lots of upcoming events that we would like to share with you. EYFS have had a lovely first week of full time. The teachers are very proud of the children and how they are beginning to build friendships and to understand the school rules. We kindly ask you to name all of your child's belongings to encourage them to take responsibility of their own items to support a smoother transition.

The Big Ambition

The Children's Commissioner for England, Dame Rachel de Souza, has launched The Big Ambition, a national survey of children and young people across England. The Big Ambition aims to hear from children across England on what they think is important! In the lead up to the next General Election, the Children's Commissioner wants to take children's thoughts, opinions and ideas to decision-makers, to make sure that the Government hears young people's voices on what they think needs to be done to make children's lives better in England. Kelly's Heroes Mufti Day

We will set up a payment option via Arbor to collect the donations.

New school times

The school day starts at 8.45am and ends at 3.15pm. Any children who arrive at school after 8:55am will be marked as late and children arriving after 9am will have an unauthorised mark logged. Phonics and reading activities start at 9am and it is vital your child is in school for these times.

Enrichment Clubs

Over the school year each teacher will be running a 6 week club over the year to enrich our curriculum offer. These clubs are in addition to the existing clubs currently on offer, will be on a first come, first offered basis and will be booked via our Arbor system. We have been a little rushed sending out information to parents regarding clubs starting this week due to the new school year however we are planning to give parents more notice for clubs and open bookings later in the day to give parents who do not have access to phones/notifications during the day a chance to book. We do have limited numbers in each club and we are finding that they book up very quickly.

Book time

Book time has started for Years 1 & 2. All parents or relatives are invited to come in and hear their child read from 8.45am to 9am. Please enter via your child's classroom door if you wish to attend.





Flashback Friday for Years 2-6

Parents are invited to join the Flashback Friday session at 2.45pm on Friday 20th October. Flashback Fridays are designed to support the child recap prior learning and to discover what learning will occur the following week. A weekly PowerPoint will continue to be shared with you so you are aware of the learning that has and will take place.

We do ask that when parents attend the Flashback Friday event that you help us by being respectful and listening to the class teacher as this session is a teaching activity, if a younger sibling is disruptive we ask politely for you to remove the child to the corridor. All pushchairs are to remain outside to not block fire exits. Thank you for your support with this matter.

Communication procedures

When contacting the school, please be aware you will be expected to provide a brief description of your request to talk/meet with staff members. Where practical, please send in a note with your child to hand to the Teacher or email on the class email address classname@redwellprimary.co.uk

- 3) SENDCo / Pastoral (where relevant)
- 4) Assistant Principal or Vice Principal
- 5) Principal

In the case of a child's absence, parents/carers are expected to notify the school by 9am or a text prompt will be sent.
