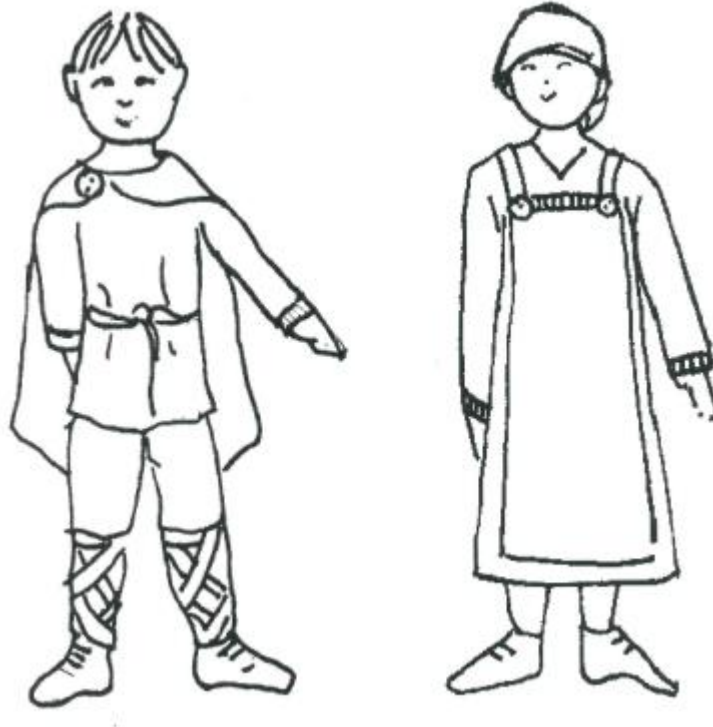
**Boys Saxon Costume:**
