Dear Parent/Carers,

We are approaching the end of the term and the classes are finalising their end of term presentations to parents to showcase what the children have been learning this term. These will be sent out to you during the last week of term via the Arbor app or email.

Unfortunately during the last week Covid-19 is very much high on everyone's agenda once again. I am writing to you to outline what we can all do as a community to protect one another.

The number of confirmed cases in school is still very low and the updated risk assessment can be found on our school website.

As you will be aware, currently children do not need to isolate if they have been a close contact to anyone who tests positive for Covid-19 unless they live in the same household. If someone in the same household tests positive then we will be asking you take your child for a PCR test, isolate until the results are in and if negative, they can return to school. The advice is also that adults in the household or children of secondary school age, who test negative on a PCR but have been a close contact, take a daily lateral flow test. This also applies to anyone who is double vaccinated.

At present, we understand that the new variant has currently changed the isolation rules and could potentially cause a lot of disruption for our school and the children, families, and staff within it. Anyone who is identified as a close contact to someone who tests positive for Covid-19 Omicron variant will have to isolate for 10 days regardless of age or vaccination status.

The following actions will help our school community:

Face coverings:

We ask that all visitors wear face coverings when entering our school – if you are exempt then please wear a lanyard to indicate this. Staff are wearing masks in communal areas where they cannot socially distance.

Symptoms:

Be extra vigilant on monitoring your child for any symptoms of Covid-19 (cough, high temperature, loss of sense of smell or taste) and seek a PCR test if your child displays these symptoms. Please be considerate of the fact that we are also being extra vigilant and if we contact you to ask you to collect your child and get them a PCR test please remember that we are following government guidance. Anyone with symptoms, however mild, must isolate at home until the results of a PCR test are known.

Lateral flow tests:

The guidance for schools asks that all secondary age students and all school staff take part in lateral flow tests twice a week. The staff in school are taking part in these tests and it has enabled us to quickly identify Covid-19 cases - some of which have been asymptomatic. They can be ordered from the NHS website.

We ask that all visitors take a lateral flow test the day of the performance and to wear a mask unless you are exempt – please wear a lanyard to indicate this if possible.

This will be limited to one adult per child per event and masks are to be worn at all times. We will be sending out a link on the Arbor parent app to sign up if you wish to attend or a family member wishes to attend. We will continue to update you if there are any changes due to Covid restrictions. We are also advising that **no photographs or videos will be allowed** during the performances as we have children who cannot be photographed for safeguarding reasons. Due to this, we are recording the performances for you and will send you a copy after the 14th December as the children who cannot be photographed will be exempt from the recordings. Performances will be held in the Sports Hall. **Please enter via the Sports Hall gate – the gate will open automatically when you are able to enter the building/sign in.**

Parent Council and RHH launch – One last plea!
